Objectives:

General objectives of the Action:

- Improving the quality of HE in 3rd countries not associated to the programme (hereafter TCnAP), enhancing its relevance for the labour market and society and the level of competences, skills and employability potential of students by developing new and innovative education programmes;
- Promoting inclusive education, equality, equity, non-discrimination and the promotion of civic-competences in HE in TCnAP;
- Enhancing the teaching, assessment mechanisms for HEI staff and students, QA, management, governance, inclusion, innovation, knowledge base, digital and entrepreneurial capacities, as well as the internationalisation
- Increasing the capacities of HEIs, bodies in charge of HE and competent authorities of TCnAP to modernise their HE systems;
- Improving the training of teachers and continuous professional development in order to impact the longer term quality of the education system in the TCnAP;
- Stimulating cooperation of institutions, capacity building and exchange of good practice and fostering cooperation across different regions of the world through joint initiatives.

Geographical Targets:

- **National projects** involving institutions from only one eligible TCnAP
- **Multi-country (regional) projects** within one single eligible region
- **Multi-country and cross-regional projects** involving at least one country from each eligible region

Activities:

- Attract less experienced HEIs and small-scale actors to **facilitate access to newcomers**.
- **Small scale projects** to reduce the **internationalization** gap, develop cooperation ideas and facilitate the **transfer of know-how** and expertise, improving social inclusion to a qualitative HE offers.
- Activities aiming at a) **enhancing** the management/administrative capacity of the targeted HEIs b) **ensuring** high quality and relevant education c) **increasing** the accessibility of the students/ staff with fewer opportunities

Horizontal Priorities:

- **Environmental sustainability** – development of competences in various sustainability, green skills, strategies, methodologies and future oriented curricula
- **Inclusion and diversity** – better participation of people with fewer opportunities
- **Digital transformation** – improvement of resilience of HE systems, fostering the use of digital technologies pedagogy for accessible technologies
- **Civic engagement and participation** – strengthening active citizenship and governance in HEIs
- **Growth & jobs** – building skills for life (soft, foundation and STEM skills)
