What is "Flexi-Comp"?

The Flexi-Comp project developed a flexible digital competence framework for educators working in the VET sector built on existing EU competence frameworks in particular 'DigCompEdu'.

Through this project, we incorporated a set of competences that enables educators to use digital tools to work with vulnerable groups, so as to in turn improve their digital competences and knowledge. In addition, the project embeds the framework in 'situational knowledge-based practice' so as to support educators to understand how to apply digital competences in real teaching and learning situations.

The partners developed through Flexi-Comp an online learning programme using micro-learning and game-based learning, to enable educators to acquire these competences and apply them in practice. A pilot of the program was provided to 200 learners from four different VET contexts – school-based vocational training, college and further education training, vocational training for vulnerable young people and continuing vocational training for adult learners. From that, the project developed a Toolkit for scaling the programme up and out.

Flexi-Comp competence framework

The Flexi-Comp competence framework and pedagogic approach was developed and used to design the Flexi-Comp training programme. The main aims of the research were to identify the key competences required for VET educators and the 'critical incidents' they are likely to experience when working on the ground with disadvantaged learners and digitally excluded people

Transferability Toolkit

Transferability Toolkit is aimed at policymakers, businesses, training providers, and VET practitioners to aid in the replication, adaptation, and sustainability of Flexi-Comp. The Toolkit approach is based on 'Ten Steps to Transferability,' each of which guides the reader through the process of developing and customising their local FLEXI-COMP programme to meet local needs, from familiarisation with the programme and tools to adaptation and customisation, and finally to evaluation and sustainability.
